# Discipleship Ministry



**COUNTING SHEEP** is a joint community service project with the support of the church mission committee and interchurch ministries. The goal is to build and provide basic functional beds with bedding for children in the area currently sleeping on the floor or without a suitable bed. After seeing other communities providing this service, we determined there was a need in the local area and set the idea in motion. The mission committee will be assisting with the application and selection process. We will be asking for volunteers to assist with building beds, delivering beds, and assisting with workdays in the future. Also, we will be accepting financial donations as well as child and teen themed

bedding. Flyers with the application are available from the First United Methodist Church office.

We have delivered three beds in Lucas County and will be delivering seven more in early January. We have also approved two more beds which the client is not ready for delivery. Every child deserves a bed.

## Pastoral Pondering . . . .

One thing we know for sure about spring is that April showers will bring May flowers. But there are some important questions, like when exactly those flowers will bloom (we're looking at you, Mr. Groundhog). And when Easter and other important dates during Lent will fall. With all the festive family gatherings, Easter egg hunts, and Sunday feasts, each household finds its own way to commemorate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ during the beloved holiday of Easter. Before the grand celebration, it's crucial to acknowledge another significant date: Ash Wednesday.

Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024, marks the beginning of Lent – this year it just so happens that it falls on Valentine's Day, a day to express our love and affection for another. We will send cards, chocolate, flowers, and worship at church to be marked with ash, to be reminded of our mortality, and to know that from dust we came and to dust we shall return. It is a time to ponder and expand our relationship with God, and to ask – when and where will you meet God?

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent, this period of 40 days and 40 nights is a time of preparation before entering the promised land that flows with "milk and honey." It's the journey to the cross. It's a solemn season. We just celebrated the birth of Christ, and now our attention turns to his death by crucifixion. We recognize the grief of this season, sit in it, and then of course on Easter Sunday, we celebrate the life and resurrection of Jesus! Full victory over sin and death.

The culmination of Lent is Easter Sunday, March 31, 2024. On our Lenten journey everyone tries to make sense of the world and how the world works. Our world so needs love during these desperate days of radical polarization and division. This year as we make our journey to the empty tomb, we will pause to view "The Jesus Film" to remind us of God's love for us and the sacrifice he made on our behalf. "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him." (John 3:16-17).

Why Film? To hear a story is powerful. But to see it happen — and to hear Jesus speak in your language — is life-changing. That's why Jesus Film Project chose video to introduce Jesus to the world. We will see the film in five parts during Lent on Wednesday evenings at First Lutheran in Chariton and on Sunday morning in Corydon. I believe that you might wish to set aside all these Wednesdays or Sundays so that you see the entire film and not just parts — we'll begin on Wednesday, February 21st in Chariton and Sunday, February 18th in Corydon.

Lent is a time for spiritual renewal knowing that God so loves us that He gave His only Son, Jesus the Christ, to open the door to an abundant and eternal life.
