# Pastoral Pondering . . . .

Easter provides us the opportunity to celebrate every aspect of our Christian faith. As Easter represents the culmination of the Life, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ, in all its fullness, it is a day of wonderful joy!

The joy of Easter revolves around the freedom that God only can give. As Americans, we often look to freedom as one of our great societal gifts. But the freedom that God offers is something much deeper. As individuals, created in the image and likeness of God, we are called to see freedom as the gift to love as God loves. On its negative side, cultural freedom can be an invitation to do what one wants, when and how one wants it. The freedom found in Christ is the blessing of God's grace, His undeserved love for us. When we sit and pray quietly and think of those times when we have truly been loved by someone else, we get a taste of the freedom God gives us. God invites every one of us to live freely in order to inspire others to reach their personal potential. True love is the gift of self to another. When someone is truly loved by another, we experience the inspiration to love in return.

On Easter morning the ladies heard the messenger say: "He is not here, for he has been raised!" (Matt. 28:6), to which we respond: "He is risen indeed!"

Do you know people who always walk around with a tune in their head, singing it for everyone to hear? As I reflect on the awesome and wonderful journey with our confirmation students over the past few years, I am reminded of the wonderful stories (tunes) that they shared about baseball and softball, cattle and pigs, prom music and dancing – stories about special friends and moments in their lives. Stories of life! Stories of faith! Stories grounded in the love of their gracious God.

In the Gospel of Matthew we read how an angel appeared to the women at the tomb early that first Easter morning. The angel explained to them that Jesus was not there because he had been raised from the dead, just as he said! Matthew tells us that the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid - yet filled with joy.

That's what the resurrection does. It takes our fear, our worry, our hurt, our sadness...and it puts it all into perspective.

The fact that Jesus is risen from the dead, that he was victorious over death and sin, is reason for all of us to continue celebrating. The resurrection of Jesus from the grave brings joy to all of us despite doubt and challenge which confront us each and every day. What happened on that first Easter morning continues to inspire us with joy; and, changes our outlook about the future.

I pray you will join with us on Easter Sunday (March 31) to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. And as you do, you will find a fantastic joy and blessing in celebrating the awesome gifts of faith and assurance in all that you do! Come, rejoice, and sing as we celebrate how Jesus continues to inspire us to walk and live by faith and in the assurance of His risen presence each and every day!
